
## Notice of Commencement of Works- Spat Collector Deployment

Project Works

Spat collector deployment for The Wild Oysters Project, Conwy Bay (license number: DEML2284), is due to take place **between 23<sup>rd</sup> August and 10<sup>th</sup> September**. The works will involve deploying two spat collectors, a type of aquaculture equipment, onto the seabed undertaken by the Conwy Harbour Authority, using the vessel **Jac Y Do**. Both collectors will be buoyed.
