

Rules and Guidelines:

- Self-Check for COVID symptoms before you leave, taking lateral flow tests if these
 are available. Bring your own hand sanitiser and mask for when you cannot socially
 distance from others. If you start showing symptoms, as any point, contact your club
 covid officer ASAP.
- Observe Government Social Distancing before and after your game. No congregating in groups of more than 6.
- Visiting teams may arrive when they like, but must know that there are no changing facilities or covered areas to stand in bad weather. Therefore we advise only arriving with enough time to complete a warm up.
- Teams can only enter the pitch once it has been cleared of the previous players.
 There are no adequate dugouts on the pitch so visiting teams please use the far side of the pitch.
- GK's should change as much as possible after arriving at the grounds and before entering the pitch.
- There are toilet facilities on site but only use the one shown on the diagram. One in one out rules apply.
- Do not congregate in groups larger than 6 before entering the pitch or anywhere outside the pitch. If you are in a small space, we advise you wear facemasks if 2m distancing is not possible.
- For spectators, please remain outside the pitch and socially distance (2m) in groups
 of no more than 6 people. Do not lean on the fence as these are not sanitised before
 and after games.
- Please leave the pitch quickly once your game has ended and do not congregate in the car park afterwards.
- Touch the ball with your stick/GK equipment and not your hands.
- Do not touch the goals, cones etc.
- Avoid shouting excessively or spitting
