New member / Existing member – Sign up for Teamapp, Club membership & GMS.

We have now gone electronic for senior members and hopefully many of our juniors to reduce the paperwork and time the committee spends running the club.

In order to become a member of Whitchurch (Shropshire) Hockey club a parent/guardian needs to sign up to Teamapp, this allows the club to manage player data, availability, selection and membership in line with their Data Privacy Policy and Safeguarding policies.

By signing up for an account you are agreeing to pay membership and adhere to the club's policies and code of conduct.

For Parents / Guardians of Under 18's

The app can be downloaded on Android or Apple or used through the website https://www.teamapp.com/app. Please sign-up for an account and search for "Whitchurch (Shropshire) HC" and request to join the club.

Fill in the requested information then click +Join (website) and select 'Parent'



Many older kids will have their own smartphone or iPad which means they can join Team App with their own account. The club still requires a guardian account to align these members, but with parental permission we can make them a Non-Primary only, as a child with their own Team App account can respond on behalf of themselves in the app. If so, they will need to select the team/s they are playing for.





In order to protect the child's details, we ask that the parent/guardian completes the Teamapp Under 18 form at the end of the document and signs and returns and these will be loaded by a member of the team on to Teamapp to create a child's account linked to the parent.

Once completed and set up you receive information on upcoming games and club updates on socials as well as being able to pay membership and training fees online.

It is now your responsibility to keep your details up to date on Teamapp as the club will not be collecting any other information.

GMS

Any player who is playing senior hockey will need to register on England Hockey Game Management System (GMS).

For Under 18's players parents need to register an account and add the Under 18 as a dependent. (Instructions on the website 'Joining our club' section)

Sign up to training via Teamapp

In order to maintain a record of attendance and plan coach requirements we ask players to register attendance in advance via Teamapp. If you have booked in and cannot make it, please unbook.

Tuesday nights - Squad training (Over age 13)

- Men & Ladies 18.30 20.00
- Men's and Ladies 1s + Invited 2s. Please discuss with the coach or captain if you are unsure about attendance.

Wednesdays nights - Club Senior & Junior training

- Men & Ladies 18.30 20.00
- All players eligible for senior games (13+) welcome, plus invited or accompanied juniors of suitable standard. Please contact the coach if unsure

Academy Training (6 to 16) – we also cater for older players who don't feel confident to join in with senior training.

- Saturday morning 10.00 to 11.30
- Paid in advance of attending via Teamapp 'Store' for half term blocks.





Lead Coach: Alex Fry

- At training players are asked to observe England Hockey's 'Planning Hockey Safely' guidance and not participate in hockey activities until the coach gives permission.
- During the Academy session children attend training that is appropriate for their age group, where their skills and abilities are assessed and if it is appropriate, they may be asked to train with a more experienced group. It often takes the coaches a couple of sessions to assess new players and we take a great deal of care ensuring that children are in the most appropriate group to maximise their enjoyment and build their confidence.
- On Arrival: Please accompany children to the pitch and sign in your child, as proof of attendance. Entry to the playing surface is only allowed following registration and a coach being present on the playing surface. Additional requirements may be required depending on COVID requirements.
- At the end of Training: Children are expected to help collect equipment and leave the pitch as soon as possible after training. Parents/Guardians who do not remain at the pitch are asked to be prompt to collect their child from the pitch. They will not be allowed to leave on their own.

We request Under 8's remain accompanied by a parent / guardian throughout the session.

Training sessions, apart from teaching hockey, are used to assess your child's skill level and all-round ability, usually in preparation for a place in a team, therefore we are looking for commitment, willingness to learn, concentration, enthusiasm and any other positive attributes your child may have and the team requires. We are very proud of our training sessions and a great deal of preparation goes into them and the coaches always appreciate good behaviour and a nice thank you at the end!

Match Details

We aim to ensure that all children get the opportunity to represent Whitchurch Hockey Club. We hope that it will be a positive experience that they will look back on with pride. We expect all representatives of the Club to act at all times in accordance with the Club Rules.





The Manager/Coach will inform you of all necessary match details (i.e. venue, meet time, pushback, kit requirements and match fee) using email, text or telephone. You will need to respond to confirm your child's availability and any transport arrangements as soon as possible.

Bad Weather: We do play in most conditions. However, poor weather or frost may mean that a session may need to be cancelled. If so, we will contact parents, by Teamapp, text, social media and put information on the club website

Hockey Club Guidelines

Whitchurch Hockey Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with either the Club captain or the club secretary.

As a member of Whitchurch Hockey Club, you are expected to abide by the following club guidelines:

- All members must play within the rules of hockey and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents and teammates. If players are unable to do this, then the coaches will warn them, and the player could be withdrawn from the match or competition.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members should wear suitable kit and coaches have the right to withdraw players who do not have the appropriate personal equipment.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.

Our policies are built upon on the following three principles:

- It is committed to providing an environment where children can learn about, participate in and enjoy Hockey free from harassment or abuse.

Information on players

Information on players is collected via Teamapp. Coaches and representatives of Whitchurch Hockey Club have access to any relevant medical information and will treat this information sensitively. Accidents

Coaches plan all sessions to be as safe as possible, however due to the nature of the game and the playing surface accidents can and do occur. We have an established first aid assessment procedure and accident reporting system.

Parent/Guardians as Volunteers

As a club we rely heavily on volunteers giving freely of their time with skills and experience in many areas not just hockey or sport in general. At **Whitchurch Hockey club** we are grateful for all those who assist us in any way from helping collect fees to helping with transport and promotion. If you can help us in any way however small, please talk to us.

As a responsible Club we will request proof of competency in working with children, including DBS checks.



If you are struggling with paying membership or cannot commit to playing a full season please come and speak with the committee as we want as many players as possible available each week, even if it's only a couple of games a season.

Membership can be paid using 'Store' on Teamapp.







Membership can be paid as of 1st July each season.

Deadline for payment of membership is 14th October 2023after which an additional £5 admin fee will be due.

Senior Match Fees

Parents will receive an invoice from the club at regular intervals throughout the season requesting payment online via BACS. We are in the process of trying to get these paid via 'Store' in Teamapp.

Whitchurch hockey club reserves the right to have membership paid in advance of playing games for players who have previously paid membership after the deadline without agreement of the treasurer or have been repeatedly late paying match fees.

Academy Training Fees

Training fees are charged in line with school half terms and are paid via the Teamapp store and are non-refundable dependent on attendance.

WHATSAPP: Is only available to those over 16 years of age.

The club only has one official WhatsApp group which is used solely for communicating upcoming events. All information regarding training and matches are done via Teamapp.

You may be asked to join other WhatsApp groups by other members of the club in order to speed up communication etc. These are personal groups setup by the individual and are not controlled or regulated by the club data protection policy.
