New member / Existing member – Sign up for Teamo, Club membership & GMS.

In order to become a member of Whitchurch (Shropshire) Hockey club each player needs to sign up to Teamo, this allows the club to manage player data, availability, selection and membership in line with the club Data Privacy Policy.

By signing up for an account you are agreeing to pay membership and adhere to the club's policies and code of conduct.

#### For Over 18's

It is now your responsibility to keep your details up to date on Teamo as the club will not be collecting any other information.

**GMS** (Instructions for sign up can be found on the club website on the 'Join our club' page.

Any player who is playing senior hockey will need to register or transfer from existing clubs on England Hockey Game Management System (GMS).

### Sign up to training via Teamo

In order to maintain a record of attendance and plan coach requirements we ask players to register attendance in advance via Teamo. If you have booked in and cannot make it, please unbook.

## Wednesdays nights - Club Senior & Junior training

 All players eligible for senior games (13+) welcome, plus invited or accompanied juniors of suitable standard. Please contact the coach if unsure.

Senior training is free during the season to anyone who is regularly playing for senior teams. For those who are not eligible or infrequent players there will be a charge of £4.00 per session. All summer training will require payment.

## Lead Coaches: Danny Foulkes / Alex Fry

- At training players are asked to observe England Hockey's 'Planning Hockey Safely' guidance and not participate in hockey activities until the coach gives permission.
- Adults and juniors attend training where their skills and abilities are assessed and if it is appropriate, they may be asked to train with a more experienced group.
- It often takes the coaches a couple of sessions to assess new players and we take a great deal of care ensuring that players are in the most appropriate group to maximise their enjoyment and build their confidence.

**Bad Weather:** We do play in most conditions. However, poor weather or frost may mean that a session may need to be cancelled. If so, we will contact parents, by Teamo, text, social media and put information on the club website.

## **Hockey Club Guidelines**

Whitchurch Hockey Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with either the Club captain or the club secretary.





As a member of Whitchurch Hockey Club, you are expected to abide by the following club guidelines:

- All members must play within the rules of hockey and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents and teammates. If players are unable to do this, then the coaches will warn them and the player could be withdrawn from the match or competition.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members should wear suitable kit and coaches have the right to withdraw players who do not have the appropriate personal equipment.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.

- It is committed to providing an environment where children can learn about, participate in and enjoy Hockey free from harassment or abuse.

### Information on players

Information on players is collected via Teamo. Coaches and representatives of Whitchurch Hockey Club have access to any relevant medical information and will treat this information sensitively. Our **Club Data Privacy policy** can be found on the website explaining how the club uses and protects your data.

#### **Accidents**

Coaches plan all sessions to be as safe as possible, however due to the nature of the game and the playing surface accidents can and do occur. We have an established first aid assessment procedure and accident reporting system.

Sign up availability for matches via Teamo by 21.00 on Monday evenings. The coaches, club captains and team captains will discuss and select teams. Players will receive confirmation of selection via Teamo usually by Wednesday. If you haven't received one, contact your normal captain.

### **Volunteers**

As a club we rely heavily on volunteers giving freely of their time with skills and experience in many areas not just hockey or sport in general. At **Whitchurch Hockey club** we are grateful for all those who assist us in any way from helping collect fees to helping with transport and promotion. If you can help us in any way however small, please talk to us.

As a responsible Club we will request proof of competency in working with children, including DBS checks.





## Membership and Match Fees (non-refundable)

If you are struggling with paying membership or cannot commit to playing a full season please come and speak with the committee as we want as many players as possible available each week, even if it's only a couple of games a season.

Membership can be paid on Teamo.

Membership can be paid as of 1st July each season.

Deadline for payment of membership is 11th October 2025 after which an additional £5 admin fee will be due.

Anyone who hasn't paid by this time will be ineligible for selection.

### Senior Match Fees (£7.00 per game in 2025/26)

Players are requested to sign up to 'Auto pay' on Teamo and match fees will be automatically collected on the first week of each month.

### AutoPay

The use of Autopay has massively reduced the burden on the clubs volunteers in the last season chasing payments from players and freeing volunteers for other projects.

The club are asking all players in 2025-26 to sign up to Autopay or contact treasurer@whitchurchhockeyclub.com if not possible.

Whitchurch hockey club reserves the right to have membership paid in advance of playing games for players who have previously paid membership after the deadline without agreement of the treasurer or have been repeatedly late paying match fees.

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** In some environments, particularly adult competition it is impossible to control photography by external parties, however, we are aware that there may be times that photographs and/or footage may be taken during matches and training sessions by approved agents and/or officers of Whitchurch HC. Such images shall





only be used for publicity/training purposes in accordance with the Whitchurch HC Photographic and Recorded Images policy. This includes any reproductions or adaptations of the images for all general purposes i.e., local newspapers, local magazines, other promotional articles (inc. flyers) and the club's website. If you do not wish your image to be used, please inform the committee.

**WHATSAPP:** The club only has one official WhatsApp group which is used solely for communicating upcoming events. All information regarding matches and team selection are done via Teamo.

You may be asked to join other WhatsApp groups by other members of the club in order to speed up communication etc. These are personal groups setup by the individual and are not controlled or regulated by the club or the club's policies.

#### **Drivers and transport to games**

- For senior matches the club will provide where possible lifts to games for all players but we rely on parents to provide lifts if this is not possible.
- The club does not allow Under 21s to drive younger players to matches from the meeting point as part of our welfare policy.
